Position:

SB 362 introduced by Sen. Basham and referred to Appropriations, would modify the EDRO statute to allow an EDRO to be filed even after the participant is receiving the pension, as long as it is filed within 120 days after the Judgment of Divorce. Although state educational pension benefits are subject to income withholding orders, this bill would allow an alternate payee to split off their share of the pension so that they were no longer dependent on the participant's continued existence for their share of the pension. The Council supported the additional options this bill would provide and voted to support this bill.
