Dear Representative Taub:

At its September 21, 2005 meeting, the State Bar of Michigan's Board of Commissioners unanimously voted to actively oppose¹ HB 5024. The position is based on a long-standing State Bar position that limiting contingency fees in turn limits the public's ability to retain counsel. This directly impacts the public's access to justice.

Consistent with its constitutional authority for supervision of the courts and regulation of the profession, the Michigan Supreme Court has addressed the issue of contingency fees in the Michigan Rules of Professional Conduct and Rules of Evidence. The State Bar believes that any changes concerning contingency fees are most appropriately addressed through changes to these rules.
