Position:

SB 602, introduced by Sens. Cherry, Prusi, and Birkholz and referred to the Committee on Families and Human Services, would allow substituted service on a non-resident parent for purposes of the Family Support Act. The Council opposes this bill. The Council felt that substituted service was not a constitutionally permissible means of obtaining the in personam jurisdiction necessary to sustain a child support order.
