Explanation of the position, including any recommended amendments:

This bill creates an Animal Welfare Fund by use of state income tax check-offs. The stated purpose of the fund is “to provide funds to promote sterilization and adoption of dogs and cats, to improve knowledge of the proper care of animals pursuant to state animal anticruelty laws by educating the public and training personnel authorized by law to enforce state animal anticruelty laws, to support and enhance programs that provide for the care and protection of animals pursuant to state anticruelty laws, and to allow the purchase of equipment and supplies for programs that receive grants under this act.”

This bill would provide a mechanism to fund these important programs, and is consistent with the Bylaws of the Animal Law Section, which include the following goals: 3.1 Educate members of the State Bar and of the public about laws relating to the protection of animals and animal rights, including the development and modification of existing law. 3.2 Promote legislation to advance animal protection and animal rights. 3.4 Promote animal protection and animal rights in Michigan through use of the legal system.
