Support with recommended amendments

# Explanation of the position, including any recommended amendments:

HB 5050 would require a child support payer with no source of income to provide the Friend of the Court with information about any financial account they hold. If an arrearage of two months or greater accrues, the Friend of the Court may request the financial institutions holding those accounts to provide information about the amount of money in those accounts and the ownership of the accounts.

The Family Law Section supports this bill in principle, but recommends that the bill be amended in two respects. The Section was concerned that "source of income" is so broadly defined under other statutes that no one would qualify as having no source of income. The Section recommends that the bill referred to self-employed and unemployed payers of support. The Section also feared the disclosure of possibly privileged information regarding

client holdings in IOLTA accounts, and suggests that a financial institution need only report the existence of the account, and that it is an IOLTA account.
