<u>SB 0554</u> (Van Woerkom) Property; other; recordable instrument conveying an interest in real property; require to specify type of road on which property is located. Amends sec. 1 of <u>1937 PA 103</u> (MCL <u>565.201</u>).

This bill would require that a recordable instrument conveying an interest in real property specify the type of road on which the property is located. Several members of the Council voiced strong concerns over the inherent ambiguities involved in determining the type of road involved in a particular conveyance and that the burden of doing so should not fall on the party recording the instrument.
