## Explanation of the position, including any recommended amendments:

This bill would allow any person with knowledge of a scrivener's error or omission to record a corrective instrument. The Titles and Conveyancing Committee requested that the Section opposed the bill because it would likely lead to more problems than it solves. In particular, in allowing any person to record instruments purporting to change existing instruments is too open to allowing abuse and clouding title creating potential slanders of title. This should be distinguished from parties to an instrument recording affidavits to correct scrivener errors, which is already permitted.
