At its January 2007 meeting, the State Bar of Michigan's Board of Commissioners unanimously voted to **oppose HB 4953**. The State Bar has a long history of opposing loser-pay legislation. Michigan law currently gives the court authority to award attorney fees and court costs on a discretionary basis in cases where the plaintiff has brought a frivolous claim. It is important to maintain a judge's discretion to determine appropriate sanctions on a case by case basis, and to avoid a mandatory system that precludes judicial review of a specific case and circumstances.
