H.B. 5196 would enact a power of attorney act. It is based on an outdated version of the Uniform Power of Attorney Act and is substantially the same as HB 4180 that was introduced in the 2007-08 legislative session and was opposed by the Section for a variety of reasons. The Council of the Section has also directed its Power of Attorney Act Committee to commence preparation of a proposed Power of Attorney Act based in part on the Uniform Power of Attorney Act.
