Explanation of the position, including any recommended amendments:

HB 5940 would disqualify noncustodial parents from receiving food stamps if they had any child support arrearage. This would be somewhat counterproductive. It would make it harder for these parents to pay their support because they would need to spend more money to be able to eat. Many "non-custodial" parents are caring for their children for extended periods of time, and this bill would starve the children that the bill is presumably trying to help. Arrearages can be created when an increase in child support is retroactive. Punishing parents for arrearages may be inflicting punishment on blameless parents. The Family Law Section opposes this bill.
